BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 19 **Article - Natural Resources** 20 10-415. 21 Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, a person with a (c) (1) 22 consolidated hunting license also may purchase bonus deer stamps for each type of 23 deer hunting season from the Department. 24 A bonus deer stamp allows the person with the consolidated hunting 25 license to hunt 1 extra deer for each stamp purchased in any of the following hunting

26 seasons for deer in the State for which the person has purchased a bonus deer stamp:

Bow and arrow season;

7 harvest in various areas of the State.

- 8 (II) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH BY REGULATION AN 9 EARLY BLACK POWDER SEASON ON TWO CONSECUTIVE FRIDAYS AND SATURDAYS IN 10 OCTOBER.
- 11 (H) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH ANTLERED AND ANTLERLESS DEER 12 HUNTING REQUIREMENTS IN EACH DEER MANAGEMENT REGION TO MEET THE 13 GOALS OF THE DEER MANAGEMENT PLAN.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
