12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA" MEANS MEASURED
17 CONCENTRATIONS OF AIR POLLUTANTS, INCLUDING AIR POLLUTANTS FOR WHICH
18 THERE ARE NO ESTABLISHED AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS OR EMISSION
19 STANDARDS, OBTAINED FROM AN AMBIENT AIR MONITOR ESTABLISHED BY THE

20 DEPARTMENT.

HOUSE BILL 502

1 (B) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2000, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE 2 PUBLIC ACCESS TO ALL AIR MONITORING DATA IN THE STATE THROUGH THE 3 INTERNET.

4 (C) AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) MAY BE IN SUMMARY FORM; AND

(2) SHALL INCLUDE ALL VALIDATED AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA
 OBTAINED DURING THE CURRENT YEAR AND THE PREVIOUS YEAR. FOR THE 2 MOST
 RECENT CALENDAR YEARS FOR WHICH DATA ARE AVAILABLE.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 1999.
