- 4 notice <u>in a certain manner</u> to parents, guardians, and staff of certain
- information regarding certain pesticide applications; authorizing certain

- 8 eertain circumstances; requiring a licensee or public agency permittee to provide
- 9 the owner or operator of a child care facility with certain material; requiring the

(2) WITHIN 24 HOURS OF AN EMERGENCY PESTICIDE 8 APPLICATION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH. THE SCHOOL CHILD 9 CARE FACILITY SHALL PROVIDE TO EACH PARENT, GUARDIAN, AND STAFF MEMBER 10 POST WRITTEN NOTIFICATION ON OR ADJACENT TO THE EXTERIOR OF THE FRONT 11 DOOR OF THE CHILD CARE FACILITY THAT INCLUDES: 12 1. THE COMMON AND TRADE NAME OF THE PESTICIDE; AND 13 2. THE DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION OF THE APPLICATION: A SUMMARY OF THE POTENTIAL ADVERSE HUMAN 14 <del>3.</del> 15 HEALTH EFFECTS BASED ON THE MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET AND THE 16 PRODUCT LABEL OF THE PESTICIDE APPLIED, INCLUDING ACUTE EFFECTS, CHRONIC 17 EFFECTS. MEDICAL CONDITIONS EXACERBATED BY EXPOSURE AND IF NOTED. 18 CARCINOGENICITY OF PESTICIDE; AND 19 THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE: "THE OFFICE OF PESTICIDE PROGRAMS OF THE UNITED STATES 21 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY HAS STATED: WHERE POSSIBLE PERSONS 22 WHO POTENTIALLY ARE MORE SENSITIVE, SUCH AS PREGNANT WOMEN AND 23 INFANTS (LESS THAN 2 YEARS OLD), SHOULD AVOID ANY UNNECESSARY PESTICIDE 24 EXPOSURE." THE LICENSEE OR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMITTEE SHALL PROVIDE THE 25 26 OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE CHILD CARE FACILITY WITH THE PRODUCT LABEL 27 AND THE MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS CONCERNING THE PESTICIDE TO BE 28 APPLIED. THE CHILD CARE FACILITY SHALL MAINTAIN THIS INFORMATION ON FILE. 29 AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC EXAMINATION. 30 <del>(F)</del> BEFORE A PESTICIDE APPLICATION UNDER THIS SECTION. (1)<del>(I)</del> 31 CHILDREN SHALL VACATE THE PORTION OF THE BUILDING OR GROUNDS TO BE 32 TREATED. 33  $\frac{(II)}{(II)}$ EVEN IF THE ONLY PART OF A ROOM TO BE TREATED IS A 34 CLOSET IN THE ENCLOSED AREA WITHIN A ROOM, CHILDREN SHALL VACATE THE 35 ROOM. - 4 IN FACILITY NOTIFICATION BEFORE A BAIT STATION IS USED IN THE CHILD CARE
- 5 FACILITY. THE MEANS MAY INCLUDE A SIGN POSTED ON THE DOOR OF THE ROOM IN
- 6 WHICH THE BAIT STATION IS PLACED.
