1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Caroline County - Education - Budget - Program Implications**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Caroline County Board of Education to provide
4 certain information about certain program implications with the annual budget
5 when requested by the ~~County Administrator and the~~ Caroline County Board of
6 ~~County Commissioners; requiring the Superintendent of Schools to submit~~
7 ~~certain information about certain program implications at a certain time when~~
8 ~~requested by the County Administrator or the County Commissioners; providing~~
9 ~~for the termination of this Act;~~ and generally relating to program implications of
10 the education budget of Caroline County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Education**

5 (G) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION,
6 THE CAROLINE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, ~~ON REQUEST OF THE COUNTY~~
7 ~~ADMINISTRATOR AND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS~~ UPON REQUEST BY THE CAROLINE
8 COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SHALL PROVIDE WITH THE ANNUAL
9 BUDGET THE PROGRAM IMPLICATIONS OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REDUCTIONS TO
10 OR INCREASES IN ITS ANNUAL BUDGET, AT WHATEVER DIFFERENT LEVELS OF
11 FUNDING AND ACCOMPANIED BY WHATEVER REASONABLE SUPPORTING DETAIL
12 AND ANALYSIS AS MAY BE SPECIFIED BY THE ~~COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND BOARD~~
13 OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. ~~PRIOR TO THE SUBMISSION OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET,~~
14 ~~SIMILAR INFORMATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF~~
15 ~~SCHOOLS UPON REQUEST BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR COUNTY~~
16 ~~COMMISSIONERS.~~

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1999. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of
19 September 30, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
20 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
