- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 5-101.

- 19 (G) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION,
- 20 THE CAROLINE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, ON REQUEST OF THE COUNTY
- 21 ADMINISTRATOR AND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SHALL PROVIDE WITH THE
- 22 ANNUAL BUDGET THE PROGRAM IMPLICATIONS OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR
- 23 REDUCTIONS TO OR INCREASES IN ITS ANNUAL BUDGET, AT WHATEVER DIFFERENT
- 24 LEVELS OF FUNDING AND ACCOMPANIED BY WHATEVER REASONABLE SUPPORTING
- 25 DETAIL AND ANALYSIS AS MAY BE SPECIFIED BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND
- 26 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. PRIOR TO THE SUBMISSION OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET,
- 27 SIMILAR INFORMATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF
- 28 SCHOOLS UPON REQUEST BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR COUNTY
- 29 COMMISSIONERS.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
