- 1 3-102. 2 This section only applies to design/build contracts and construction (b) 3 contracts. THE WSSC MAY NOT AWARD A CONTRACT TO ANY CONTRACTOR (H) (1) 5 UNLESS THE CONTRACT CONTAINS PROVISIONS OBLIGATING THE CONTRACTOR: NOT TO DISCRIMINATE IN ANY MANNER AGAINST AN (I) 7 EMPLOYEE OR AN APPLICANT FOR EMPLOYMENT ON THE BASIS OF SEX. RACE. 8 CREED, COLOR, AGE, MENTAL OR PHYSICAL HANDICAP, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, OR 9 NATIONAL ORIGIN; AND 10 (II)TO INCLUDE A SIMILAR NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE IN ALL 11 SUBCONTRACTS. 12 (2) IF THE NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE IS OMITTED FROM A 13 CONTRACT OR SUBCONTRACT SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION: 14 (I) THE WSSC MAY DECLARE THE CONTRACT TO BE VOID; AND 15 THE CONTRACTOR IS ENTITLED TO THE REASONABLE VALUE (II)16 OF WORK THAT HAS BEEN PERFORMED AND MATERIALS THAT HAVE BEEN
