13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article - Health Occupations
16	14-315.
17	(a) The Board shall issue a license free of charge to any physician who:
18 19	(1) Provides medical services to patients for which the physician receives no personal remuneration;
20	(2) Is not engaged in the private practice of medicine; and
21	(3) Otherwise qualifies for a license under this title.
22 23	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, each license issued under this section expires on the [first] SECOND anniversary of the date on which it

24 is issued and may be renewed [annually] EVERY 2 YEARS on application to the Board.

4 (2) On receipt of this notice, the Board shall charge the physician the 5 license fee otherwise required under this subtitle.
