3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Comptroller to prescribe by regulation a

- 4 method to ensure that licensed cigarette retailers pay licensed cigarette
- 5 wholesalers and subwholesalers in full and in a timely manner for certain
- 6 outstanding invoices; specifying the content of a certain regulation; providing for
- 7 certain disciplinary action against licensed wholesalers and subwholesalers for
- 8 a violation of this Act; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally
- 9 relating to the regulation of certain cigarette licensees.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation

(A) THE COMPTROLLER BY REGULATION SHALL PRESCRIBE A METHOD TO
 ENSURE THAT A LICENSED RETAILER PAYS A LICENSED WHOLESALER OR LICENSED
 SUBWHOLESALER IN FULL AND IN A TIMELY MANNER FOR OUTSTANDING INVOICES
 FOR CIGARETTES THE LICENSED WHOLESALER OR LICENSED SUBWHOLESALER
 SELLS TO THE LICENSED RETAILER.

24 (B) A REGULATION THAT THE COMPTROLLER ADOPTS UNDER SUBSECTION (A) 25 OF THIS SECTION SHALL:

14 (C) A LICENSED WHOLESALER OR LICENSED SUBWHOLESALER WHO
15 VIOLATES THIS SECTION, OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE COMPTROLLER
16 UNDER THIS SECTION, IS SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER § 16-210 OF THIS
17 SUBTITLE.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2000.
