- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (A) In addition to the powers and duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the
- 17 Board has the following powers and duties:
- 18 (1) To adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title;
- 19 (2) To adopt a code of ethics;
- 20 (3) To adopt an official seal;
- 21 (4) To hold hearings and keep records and minutes necessary for the
- 22 orderly conduct of business; and
- 23 (5) To issue a list annually of all currently licensed social workers.
- 24 (B) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE PRACTICE OF
- 25 CASE MANAGEMENT BY A SOCIAL WORKER THAT:

- 9 October 1, 1999.
