- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Insurance
- 14 19-406.
- 15 (a) An insurer may not cancel a workers' compensation insurance policy before 16 its expiration unless, at least [30] 45 days before the date of cancellation, the insurer:
- 17 (1) serves on the employer, by personal service or registered mail
- 18 addressed to the last known address of the employer, a notice of intention to cancel
- 19 the policy; and
- 20 (2) files a copy of the notice with the State Workers' Compensation
- 21 Commission.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 1999.
