SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 1 Article - Real Property

- 3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL RESIDENTIAL LEASES OR SUBLEASES IN
- 4 EFFECT ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1999, WHICH HAVE AN INITIAL TERM OF 99 YEARS
- 5 AND WHICH CREATE A LEASEHOLD ESTATE, OR SUBLEASEHOLD ESTATE, SUBJECT
- 6 TO THE PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL GROUND RENT.
- 7 (B) IN ANY SUIT, ACTION, OR PROCEEDING BY A LANDLORD, OR THE
- 8 TRANSFEREE OF THE REVERSION IN LEASED PROPERTY, TO RECOVER BACK RENT,
- 9 THE LANDLORD, OR THE TRANSFEREE OF THE REVERSION IN LEASED PROPERTY:
- $10~{\mbox{\scriptsize (1)}}$  IS ENTITLED TO DEMAND OR RECOVER NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS  $11~{\mbox{\scriptsize BACK RENT; AND}}$
- 12 (2) UNLESS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN THE LEASE OR ORDERED BY A
- 13 COURT, IS NOT ENTITLED TO RECOVER ATTORNEY'S FEES FROM THE TENANT OR
- 14 ASSIGNEE OF A LEASE.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 16 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 17 on or application to any suit, action, or proceeding for back rent before the effective
- 18 date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 October 1, 1999.
