- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Business Regulation** 2 11-626. 3 (a) (1) The Advisory Committee consists of [5] 6 members appointed by the 4 Commission with the approval of the Secretary. 5 Of the [5] 6 members of the Advisory Committee: (2) 6 1 shall be nominated by the chairman of the Commission and be (i) 7 another member of the Commission; [1] 2 shall be nominated by the chairman of the Commission (ii) 9 and EACH ONE shall represent a SEPARATE TO REPRESENT EACH harness racing 10 licensee; 2 shall be nominated by a majority vote of the organization that 11 (iii) 12 represents a majority of Standardbred Breeders in the State, and 1 of those 13 recommended shall be a commercial breeder as defined by the Commission; and 14 1 shall be nominated by a majority vote of the Cloverleaf (iv) 15 Standardbred Owners Association, Inc. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 17 October 1, 1999.
