HOUSE BILL 986

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 (A) THE GOVERNOR AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY PROVIDE CAPITAL
6 MATCHING GRANTS TO NONPUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT
7 ARE MEMBERS OF THE MARYLAND INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY
8 ASSOCIATION.

9 (B) INSTITUTIONS RECEIVING THE MATCHING GRANTS WILL BE SELECTED BY 10 THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT COLLEGES AND APPROVED BY THE 11 STATE.

12 (C) REGULATIONS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PROGRAM SHALL BE
13 ESTABLISHED BY THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION IN
14 CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY
15 ASSOCIATION AND SHALL INCORPORATE IN ITS ENTIRETY THE CAPITAL REVIEW AND
16 INSTITUTIONAL SELECTION PROCESS ESTABLISHED BY THE MARYLAND
17 INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION.

(D) STATE FUNDS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION CAPITAL PROJECTS SELECTED BY
THE MARYLAND INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION AND
APPROVED BY THE STATE SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE LOUIS L. GOLDSTEIN CAPITAL
ASSISTANCE MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 1999.
