4 (i) the name and home address of each individual who examines or 5 copies a statement under this section; and

6 (ii) the name of the individual whose statement was examined or 7 copied.

8 (2) On the request of the individual whose statement was examined or 9 copied, the Ethics Commission shall forward a copy of that record to that individual.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 11 effect October 1, 1999.

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
