- 16 (a) (1) In this section "pet" means a domesticated animal.
- 17 (2) "Pet" does not include livestock.
- 18 (b) The measure of damages for tortious injuries to a pet is THE GREATER OF
- 19 the market value of the pet before the injury or the reasonable cost of veterinary
- 20 care[, but not more than \$2,500 if such charge is greater].
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1999.
