THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN DORCHESTER COUNTY. 15 (A) 16 THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A 1-DAY WINE 17 TASTING (WT) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE. 18 A WT LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A BEER, WINE 19 AND LIQUOR (BWL) LICENSE, A BEER AND WINE (BW) LICENSE, OR A CLASS A WINE 20 (W) LICENSE. 21 (2) A WT LICENSE PERMITS THE CONSUMPTION OF WINE FOR TASTING 22 OR SAMPLING IF: 23 (I) THE LICENSEE IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL THE WINE; AND A CONSIDERATION FOR THE WINE IS NOT CHARGED OR 24 (II)25 EXACTED FROM THE CONSUMER.
