- 15 (a) Any person who wilfully destroys, mutilates, defaces, injures, or removes
- 16 any tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure placed in any cemetery, or any
- 17 building, wall, fence, railing, or other work, for the use, protection, or ornamentation
- 18 of any cemetery in this State is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more
- 19 than [\$5,000] \$10,000, or imprisoned for not more than [3] 6 years, or both.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 1999.
