## Education - Public School Holidays - Presidents' Day

3 FOR the purpose of establishing Presidents' Day as a public school holiday; repealing

- 4 certain provisions of law requiring a public school to devote part of the day to
- 5 appropriate activities on Washington's Birthday and Lincoln's Birthday; and
- 6 generally relating to public school holidays in the State.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 11 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 (2) If the federal and State observances of a holiday are on different 9 days, the board of education of each county shall determine which date shall be the 10 date of observance for the public schools within the county.
