- 1 (1) A STANDING COMMITTEE AS DEFINED IN § 2-101(F) OF THIS TITLE 2 OR A SUBCOMMITTEE OF A STANDING COMMITTEE;
- 3 (2) A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE CREATED BY STATUTE OR A 4 SUBCOMMITTEE OF A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE;
- 5 (3) THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR A SPECIAL COMMITTEE 6 APPOINTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE UNDER § 2-407(B)(3) OF THIS 7 TITLE; OR

- 20 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
