- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before December
- 2 31, 2001, and on or before December 31, 2003, the State Board of Education shall
- 3 submit a report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
- 4 Government Article, the General Assembly, on the impact of this Act on teacher
- 5 recruitment and teacher shortages at Maryland's public schools.
- 6 <u>SECTION 3.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 October 1, 1999 July 1, 1999. It shall remain in effect for a period of 3 5 years and, at
- 8 the end of June 30, 2002 2004, with no further action required by the General
- 9 Assembly, this Act shall be terminated and of no further force and effect.
