15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 17 **Article - Labor and Employment**

18 8-1601.

- 19 (a) In this subtitle the following terms have the meanings indicated.
- 20 "Self-employment assistance activities" means activities approved by the (b)
- 21 Secretary in which an individual participates for the purpose of establishing a
- 22 business and becoming self-employed. Self-employment assistance activities may
- 23 include, but are not limited to, entrepreneurial training, business counseling, and
- 24 technical assistance.

- 1 (c) "Self-employment assistance allowance" means an allowance payable, in 2 lieu of regular unemployment insurance benefits, from the unemployment insurance
- 3 trust fund to an individual who meets the requirements of this subtitle.
- 4 (d) "Self-employment assistance program" means a program under which an
- 5 individual who meets the requirements described in § 8-1604 of this subtitle is
- 6 eligible to receive an allowance in lieu of regular unemployment insurance benefits
- 7 for the purpose of assisting that individual in establishing a business and becoming
- 8 self-employed.
- 9 (e) "Regular benefits" means benefits payable to an individual under this title,
- 10 including benefits payable to federal civilian employees and to ex-servicemembers as
- 11 defined in 5 U.S.C. § 8521(a) who are eligible for unemployment insurance benefits
- 12 for ex-servicemembers under 5 U.S.C. § 8521.

- 14 Unless the result would be inconsistent with this subtitle, the provisions of this
- 15 title that apply to claims for or the payment of regular benefits shall apply to
- 16 self-employment assistance allowances.

- 18 (a) The weekly amount of a self-employment assistance allowance payable to
- 19 an individual under this subtitle is equal to the weekly benefit amount for regular
- 20 benefits otherwise payable under this title.
- 21 (b) The maximum self-employment assistance allowance paid under this
- 22 subtitle may not exceed the maximum amount of benefits established under § 8-808
- 23 of this title.

- 25 (a) Self-employment assistance benefits will be payable pursuant to the
- 26 eligibility requirements of this subtitle.
- 27 (b) An individual may be paid a self-employment assistance allowance if the
- 28 individual:
- 29 (1) is determined eligible to be paid regular unemployment insurance
- 30 benefits except for the requirements described in subsection (c) of this section;
- 31 (2) is identified by a worker profiling system, as outlined in the Code of
- 32 Maryland Regulations, as an individual likely to exhaust regular unemployment
- 33 insurance benefits;
- 34 (3) has filed an application for participation in a self-employment
- 35 assistance program within 60 days of filing an initial claim for benefits and has
- 36 provided the information the Secretary may prescribe;

1 (4) has, at the time the application is filed, a balance of regular benefits 2 equal to at least 18 times the individual's weekly benefit amount in the individual's 3 benefit year; 4 has been accepted into a program approved by the Secretary that will 5 provide self-employment assistance activities; 6 is participating in self-employment assistance activities; (6)7 is actively engaged on a full-time basis in activities, which may 8 include training, relating to establishing a business and becoming self-employed; and has filed a weekly claim for the self-employment assistance 10 allowance and provided the information the Secretary prescribes. A self-employment assistance allowance is payable on the same terms and 12 subject to the same conditions as regular unemployment insurance benefits except 13 that: 14 the requirements of § 8-903 of this title relating to availability for (1) 15 work and actively seeking work are not applicable to the individual; the requirements of § 8-1005 of this title relating to refusal to accept 16 17 referrals or offers of suitable work are not applicable to the individual; 18 the provisions of § 8-803(d) of this title concerning subtracting any 19 wages in excess of \$70 will not apply to the individual; an individual will be considered unemployed for the purposes of § 20 (4) 21 8-801 of this title; and 22 an individual who fails to participate in self-employment activities or (5) 23 who fails to actively engage on a full-time basis in activities, which may include 24 training, related to establishing a business and becoming self-employed is denied for 25 the week in which the failure occurs. 26 8-1605. 27 The aggregate number of individuals receiving a self-employment assistance 28 allowance at any time shall not exceed 5 percent of the individuals receiving regular 29 unemployment insurance benefits at that time. 30 8-1606.

- 3 into the self-employment assistance program may be filed with the Secretary within
- 4 15 days after the Secretary mailed or otherwise delivered the decision.
