3 FOR the purpose of altering the requirements for individuals seeking licensure as

2 (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 15-320 of this subtitle, the Board, on 3 the affirmative vote of a majority of its members then serving, may deny a license to 4 any applicant, reprimand any licensee, or suspend or revoke a license if:

5 the applicant or licensee fraudulently or deceptively obtains, (1)6 RENEWS, or attempts to obtain OR RENEW a license OR PERMIT for the applicant or 7 licensee or for another;

8 (2)the applicant or licensee fraudulently or deceptively uses a license;

9 (3)under the laws of the United States or of any state, the applicant or 10 licensee is convicted of:

11 (i) a felony; or

12 (ii) a misdemeanor that is directly related to the fitness and 13 qualification of the applicant or licensee to practice land surveying or property line 14 surveying;

15 the applicant or licensee is guilty of gross negligence, incompetence, (4) 16 or misconduct while practicing land surveying or property line surveying;
