1 AN ACT concerning

Uninsured Employers' Fund - Special Fund

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the Workers' Compensation

4 Commission pay certain tax money into the General Fund to reimburse the

5 State for the expense of administering the Uninsured Employers' Fund;

6 repealing altering a provision of law that requires the suspension and

7 resumption of a certain assessment depending on the amount of the Uninsured

8 Employers' Fund; requiring the proposed annual budget of the Uninsured

9 Employers' Fund to include an appropriation to fund the Fund's operations; and

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(f) The Commission shall pay the money that it collects for the tax under this
section into the State Treasury to reimburse the State for the expense of
administering[:

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Commission shall
impose against an employer or, if insured, its insurer an assessment equal to 1% of:

24 (1) each award against the employer for permanent disability or death, 25 including awards for disfigurement or mutilation; and

26 (2) each amount payable by the employer or its insurer under a 27 settlement agreement approved by the Commission.

28 (b) [Notwithstanding the limit on the balance of the Fund under § 9-1011 of 29 this subtitle, if] IF the Board determines that the reserves of the Fund are inadequate 30 to meet anticipated losses, the Board may direct the Commission to assess an 31 additional 1% under subsection (a) of this section.

32 (c) Any fractional dollar of payment under this section shall be rounded off to 33 the nearest whole dollar.

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1 (d) The Commission shall direct payment of an assessment under subsection 2 (a) or (b) of this section into the Fund.

3 (e) Payments under this section are in addition to the payment of
4 compensation to a covered employee or the dependents of a covered employee under
5 this title.

7 (a) (1) When the amount of the Fund equals at least \$2,500,000 \$5,000,000,
8 the payment of assessments by employers and insurers is suspended.

9 (2) The Director shall notify each self-insured employer and insurer of 10 the suspension of the payment of assessments under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

11 (b) (1) Payment of assessments shall be resumed if:

12 (i) the amount of the Fund becomes less than \$1,000,000
13 \$3,000,000 because of payments made under § 9-1002 of this subtitle or other
14 payments; or

15(ii)the Director determines that payments that are likely to be16made from the Fund in the next 3 months will reduce the amount of the Fund to less17than \$1,000,000 \$3,000,000.

18 (2) When payment of assessments is to be resumed under paragraph (1) 19 of this subsection, the Director shall notify each self-insured employer and insurer 20 that payment of assessments is to:

(i) resume on a specified date; and

22 (ii) continue until the amount of the Fund becomes at least 23 \$2,500,000.] \$5,000,000.

25 (a) The Board shall supervise the administration of the Fund.

26 (b) (1) The Fund annually shall submit to the Governor a proposed budget 27 for the Fund, for inclusion in the budget bill to be submitted to the General Assembly.

(2) [General Fund of the State for the administrative costs of the Board] FUND FOR ITS
(3) BUDGET.
