- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) In this article the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 17 (b) "CLOCK HOUR" MEANS A MINIMUM OF 50 MINUTES OF ACTUAL CLASS
- 18 TIME OR FOR EACH 60-MINUTE HOUR.
- 19 (C) "Consumer member" means a nonprofessional member of a regulatory unit 20 who is appointed from the general public.
- 21 [(c)] (D) "County" means a county of the State and, unless expressly provided
- 22 otherwise, Baltimore City.
- 23 [(d)] (E) "Department" means the Department of Labor, Licensing, and
- 24 Regulation.

- [(e)] (F) "Partnership" includes a partnership registered as a limited liability 1 2 partnership authorized by Title 9 or Title 9A of the Corporations and Associations 4 [(f)](G) "Person" means an individual, receiver, trustee, guardian, personal 5 representative, fiduciary, or representative of any kind and any partnership, firm, 6 association, corporation, or other entity. 7 "Secretary" means the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation. [(g)](H) 8 [(h)] "State" means: (I) 9 a state, possession, territory, or commonwealth of the United States; (1) 10 or 11 (2) the District of Columbia.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 1999.
