- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 **Article - Insurance** 2 15-829.
- 3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE
- 5 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS ON AN
- 6 EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS
- 7 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND
- HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE HOSPITAL, 8 (2)
- 9 MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS
- 10 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.
- AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR A
- 12 PROSTHESIS THAT HAS BEEN PRESCRIBED BY A PHYSICIAN FOR AN ENROLLEE OR
- 13 INSURED WHO HAS UNDERGONE A MASTECTOMY AND HAS NOT HAD BREAST
- 14 RECONSTRUCTION.
- A POLICY OR CONTRACT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY NOT IMPOSE A (C) 15 16 DEDUCTIBLE ON THE COVERAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 22 policies or contracts issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after October 1,
- 23 1999.

- 25 October 1, 1999.
