- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT CAUSE THE DEATH OF A CHILD AS A RESULT OF
- 22 GROSS NEGLIGENCE.
- 23 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON
- 24 CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT
- 25 EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 26 (C) (1) AN INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, OR OTHER CHARGING DOCUMENT
- 27 UNDER THIS SECTION NEED NOT SET FORTH THE MANNER AND MEANS OF DEATH.

SENATE BILL 231

- 1 (2) AN INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, OR OTHER CHARGING DOCUMENT 2 FOR A CRIME UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUFFICIENT IF IT SUBSTANTIALLY STATES:
- 3 "(NAME OF DEFENDANT) (DATE) IN (COUNTY) AS A RESULT OF GROSS
- 4 NEGLIGENCE KILLED (NAME OF VICTIM) AGAINST THE PEACE, GOVERNMENT, AND
- 5 DIGNITY OF THE STATE."

- A prosecution for murder or manslaughter, whether at common law or under
- 8 Article 27, §§ 407 through 411, § 387, § 388, [or] § 388A, OR § 388D, may be instituted
- 9 regardless of the time elapsed between the act or omission causing the death of the
- 10 victim and the death of the victim.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 1999.
