A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Great Blacks in Wax Museum

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$750,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Great Blacks
- 5 in Wax Museum, Inc. for certain acquisition, demolition, development, or
- 6 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject
- 7 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and
- 8 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 10 MARYLAND, That:
- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 13 City Great Blacks in Wax Museum Loan of 1999 in a total principal amount equal to
- 14 the lesser of (i) \$750,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 15 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 16 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 17 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 18 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- $21~\S~8\mbox{-}122$ of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 26 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 27 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Great Blacks
- 28 in Wax Museum, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 29 acquisition, demolition, repair, renovation, expansion, reconstruction, and capital
- 30 equipping of properties from 1600 through 1649 East North Avenue in Baltimore City,
- 31 for use as part of the Great Blacks in Wax Museum and associated facilities.

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 5 (5) (a) The grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund.
- 6 (b) No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either 7 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or 8 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds 9 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 10 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 11 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 12 (c) The grantee shall present evidence to the satisfaction of the Board of
- 13 Public Works of the provision and expenditure of the matching fund, and the Board of
- 14 Public Works shall disburse the proceeds of the grant under the provisions of this Act
- 15 for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, both to be done in installments.
- 16 (d) As the grantee provides and expends an installment of the matching 17 fund, the Board of Public Works shall disburse an installment of the proceeds of the
- 18 grant equal to the portion of the matching fund presented at that time by the grantee.
- 19 (e) This method of presentation of the matching fund in installments and
- 20 of the disbursement of the proceeds of the loan in installments that are equal to each
- 21 presentation of the matching fund shall continue until the first to occur of the
- 22 disbursement of the total amount of the grant or June 1, 2001.
- 23 (f) The grantee has until June 1, 2001, to present the final evidence
- 24 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the total matching fund will be
- 25 provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact, the
- 26 amount of the final installment of the matching fund, and the amount of the total
- 27 matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the final proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 28 final installment of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 29 this Act. After June 1, 2001, any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the
- 30 matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no
- 31 further effect.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 June 1, 1999.
