18 19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 Subject to the appropriation requirements and budgetary provisions of § (a)
- 23 3-216 of this article and upon receipt of an approval of a grant application in the form
- 24 or detail that the Secretary reasonably requires, the Department shall provide annual
- 25 grants for paratransit service provided by county or local governments, that is
- 26 complementary to fixed route service as required under the federal Americans with
- 27 Disabilities Act.

- 2 (1) Shall be determined in accordance with multiyear paratransit plans 3 approved by the Department or the Federal Transit Administration; and
- 4 (2) May not exceed a total of \$4 million statewide in any fiscal year.
