- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 5 (G) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION,
- 6 THE CAROLINE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, UPON REQUEST BY THE CAROLINE
- 7 COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SHALL PROVIDE WITH THE ANNUAL
- 8 BUDGET THE PROGRAM IMPLICATIONS OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REDUCTIONS TO
- 9 OR INCREASES IN ITS ANNUAL BUDGET, AT WHATEVER DIFFERENT LEVELS OF
- 10 FUNDING AND ACCOMPANIED BY WHATEVER REASONABLE SUPPORTING DETAILS
- 11 DETAIL AND ANALYSIS AS MAY BE SPECIFIED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 1999. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of
- 17 September 30, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
- 18 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
