- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) If a disability resulted from an injury or illness sustained in the
- 18 performance of an officer's work, the Secretary may grant work-related
- 19 administrative leave to law enforcement officers in the Department who are
- 20 temporarily disabled in the performance of their work. The work-related
- 21 administrative leave remains in effect until the State Police officer is returned to duty
- 22 or is retired by reason of those injuries. However, the work-related administrative
- 23 leave may not exceed 2 years and may not extend beyond 2 years from the illness or
- 24 injury date.
- 25 (b) (1) Payment to a law enforcement officer for work-related
- 26 administrative leave taken under this section shall be [based on two-thirds of] AT
- 27 the officer's regular pay.

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	(2) [Payment for work-related administrative leave taken under this section constitutes a separate benefit on account of accidental disability and is not a continuation of salary.
4 5 6	(3) Notwithstanding the reduced rate that an officer is paid while using work-related administrative leave, the officer] AN OFFICER WHO IS USING WORK-RELATED ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE:
7 8	(i) Continues seniority and leave accruals based on the officer's regular pay; and
	(ii) Does not lose health care benefits with the subsidy allowed in Title 2, Subtitle 5 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article solely because of use of the work-related administrative leave.
	[(4)] (3) An officer may not receive temporary total disability benefits under the Maryland Workers' Compensation Act while the officer is receiving payment under this section.
15 16	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
