- 19 RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS FOR NONINSTITUTIONALIZED SPOUSES OF PERSONS
- 20 WHO RESIDE IN AN INPATIENT MEDICAL FACILITY IN DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY
