A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Assisted Living Programs - Small Facilities - Cost and Impact Study

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to enter
- 4 into a contract with a public or private entity to conduct a study concerning the
- 5 financial cost and economic impact of the State's Assisted Living Program on
- 6 certain assisted living facilities; requiring the Secretary to submit the study to
- 7 the Governor and to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and
- 8 generally relating to certain assisted living programs.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 10 MARYLAND, That the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene shall enter into a
- 11 contract with a public or private entity for that entity to conduct a study concerning
- 12 the financial cost and economic impact of the State's Assisted Living Program under
- 13 §§ 19-1801 through 19-1805 of the Health General Article on assisted living
- 14 facilities with 16 or fewer residents.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Secretary shall
- 16 submit the study to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government
- 17 Article, to the General Assembly on or before January 1, 2000.
- 18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 July 1, 1999.
