WHEREAS, These capital grants leverage private donations and help recipients maintain academic competitiveness and financial stability; and

- WHEREAS, The nonpublic institutions benefit the State by offering a diversity
- 2 of learning opportunities and by easing enrollment pressures at public institutions of

- 4 WHEREAS, Louis L. Goldstein was a proud alumnus of Washington College and
- 5 served as Chairman of the Board of Visitors and Governors for 18 years; and
