- 2 Creation of a State Debt Baltimore City The Eubie Blake National Jazz
 Institute and Cultural Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$1,200,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Eubie Blake
- 6 National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center for certain development or
- 7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject
- 8 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and
- 9 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 14 City The Eubie Blake National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center Loan of 1999 in
- 15 a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$1,200,000 or (ii) the amount of the
- 16 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 17 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 18 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 19 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 20 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 22 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 23 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 26 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 27 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 28 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 29 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Eubie Blake
- 30 National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the
- 31 grantee") for the repair, renovation, reconstruction, construction, and capital
- 32 equipping of a building on North Howard Street in Baltimore City to be named in

- 1 honor of Eubie Blake and to be used as a modern performing arts center that would be
- 2 a home for the work of minority artists and would provide area residents with classes
- 3 and activities in the arts.
- 4 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 5 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 6 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 7 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 8 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 9 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 10 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 11 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 12 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds
- 13 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. The matching fund may consist of real
- 14 property. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
- 15 or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
- 16 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2001, to
- 17 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 18 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 19 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 20 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 21 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 22 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 June 1, 1999.
