## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 State Personnel - Payment of Wages - Direct Deposit

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Treasurer, on warrant of the State
- 4 Comptroller, to pay a wage by direct deposit; providing that the payment of
- 5 <u>certain</u> wages by direct deposit shall be made in accordance with regulations
- adopted by the State Treasurer, with the concurrence of the State Comptroller;
- 7 providing that regulations adopted by the State Treasurer may not require the
- 8 payment of wages by direct deposit for certain employees; and generally relating
- 9 to the payment of wages of State employees and officers.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 18 2-405.
- 19 (A) IN ADDITION TO THE PAYMENT OF WAGES BY CASH OR CHECK. THE STATE
- 20 TREASURER, ON WARRANT OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER, MAY PAY A WAGE BY
- 21 DIRECT DEPOSIT.

- 1 (B) <u>SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION,</u> THE PAYMENT OF WAGES
  2 BY DIRECT DEPOSIT SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED
- $3\,$  BY THE STATE TREASURER, WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER.
- 4 (C) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE STATE TREASURER UNDER
  5 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF WAGES BY
- 6 DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR ANY EMPLOYEE WHO:
- 7 (1) WAS HIRED PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REGULATIONS;
- 8 <u>OR</u>
- 9 (2) REQUESTS AN EXEMPTION TO THE PAYMENT OF WAGES BY DIRECT 10 DEPOSIT.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 1999.
