2 Calvert County Historical Society - "Linden" Project Loan of 1998

- 3 FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 163 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 4 1998, the Calvert County Historical Society "Linden" Project Loan of 1998, to
- 5 permit the Calvert County Historical Society, Inc. to use in kind contributions or
- 6 prior expended funds in the matching fund; and to expand the purpose of the
- 7 grant to include the construction of associated parking.
- 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 9 Chapter 163 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1998
- 10 Section 1
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Chapter 163 of the Acts of 1998

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That:
- 16 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 17 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Calvert
- 18 County Historical Society "Linden" Project Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount
- 19 equal to the lesser of (i) \$300,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 20 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 21 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 22 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 23 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 24 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 25 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 26 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 27 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 28 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 29 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Calvert
- 4 County Historical Society, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for
- 5 the rehabilitation, restoration, renovation, expansion, and capital equipping of the
- 6 historic building known as "Linden", located in Prince Frederick, the building to be
- 7 used as a research and education center, a historical repository, and for offices for the
- 8 Calvert County Historical Society AND ASSOCIATED PARKING FACILITIES.
- 9 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 10 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 11 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 12 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 13 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 14 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 15 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 16 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 17 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property[, in kind
- 18 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act]. THE FUND
- 19 MAY CONSIST OF IN KIND CONTRIBUTIONS OR FUNDS EXPENDED PRIOR TO THE
- 20 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the
- 21 matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of
- 22 Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The
- 23 grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public
- 24 Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the
- 25 Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State
- 26 Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund
- 27 shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in
- 28 excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 29 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 30 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 31 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 32 its interest:
- 33 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 34 and
- 35 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 36 structures.
- 37 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 38 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.
- 39 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 40 June 1, 1999.
