Task Force on Food Allergies and Restaurant Patrons

This bill establishes a ten-member Task Force on Food Allergies and Restaurant Patrons to examine the concerns of, and problems encountered by, individuals with a food allergy who eat in restaurants. The task force must recommend measures to address the problems and concerns identified by the task force and report its recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly by December 1, 2000. Staff is to be provided by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. The task force terminates on April 30, 2001.
