## Health Maintenance Organizations - Formulary Development Process - Accreditation Status

This bill requires the State Health Care Access and Cost Commission (HCACC) to include a summary of prescription drug formulary accreditation standards developed by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) in its annual HMO report card. HCACC must also include information on whether the formulary development process of each HMO evaluated complies with NCQA accreditation standards.
