**Motor Vehicles - Windshield Materials - Governmental Exemptions**

---

This bill requires the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to adopt regulations that add materials placed on a windshield of a vehicle in compliance with security measures of a federal or State government agency to the list of exemptions from the prohibition against driving with certain materials on the windshield.
