### FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

Senate Bill 211 (Senators Collins and Kellev) (Baltimore County Administration) Budget and Taxation

#### Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore County - Winfield Elementary PAL/Recreation Center

This bill provides \$600,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a facility located at 8300 Carlson Lane in Baltimore County, Maryland for use as a PAL/recreation center.

The recipient must provide matching funds by June 1, 2001.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** This \$600,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

**Local Effect:** Baltimore County grant revenue would increase by \$600,000 and expenditures could increase by \$1.2 million.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
