House Bill 112 (Delegate Rosso, et al.)

Commerce and Government Matters

Maryland Port Administration - Port Land Use Development Office - Marketing of Property

This bill requires the Port Land Use Development Office within the Maryland Port Administration to market Port Land Use Development Zone properties for uses that are both port-related <u>and port-compatible</u>. Current law requires the marketing of properties for uses that are port-related <u>or port-compatible</u>.

This bill is effective June 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: To the extent that this legislation limits employment and economic development by limiting the types of properties that may be marketed, tax revenues could decrease. Any such decrease is assumed to be minimal. The expenditures of the Port Land Use Development Office would not be affected.

Local Effect: To the extent that this legislation limits employment and economic development, tax revenues could decrease in those jurisdictions surrounding the Port of Baltimore.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
