Joint Committee on Children, Youth, and Families

This bill creates a 20-member Joint Committee on Children, Youth, and Families in the General Assembly. The new statutory committee is to identify State policies and actions that can work to achieve conditions of well-being for Maryland's children, youth, and families. The Department of Legislative Services (DLS) is to staff the committee. The committee must report to the General Assembly by December 1 of each year on its work and recommendations. The bill takes effect June 1, 1999 and terminates on May 31, 2002.
