House Bill 622 (Delegate W. Baker) Environmental Matters

Environment - Kent Island Citizens Oversight Committee

This bill requires the Governor to appoint a 12-member Kent Island Citizens Oversight Committee, subject to the approval of the members of the General Assembly of the 36th district. The committee is to (1) consult with the Maryland Port Administration regarding the redeposit of dredge spoils off the shores of Kent Island, Queen Anne's County; (2) monitor the redeposit of dredge spoils off the shores of Kent Island; and (3) hear and respond to complaints lodged by any person affected by the redeposit of dredge spoils in the waters off Kent Island.
