House Joint Resolution 12 (Washington County Delegation and Frederick County Delegation)

South Mountain Battlefield Historic Tourism Initiative Task Force

This joint resolution establishes a 13-member task force to assist the Department of Natural Resources in studying and evaluating the potential costs and benefits, and the feasibility, of establishing a State park at South Mountain, including: (1) identifying funding sources necessary to operate the State park; (2) recommending procedures for management and maintenance of the State park; and (3) ascertaining the efficacy of establishing a State park at South Mountain. Staff for the task force will be provided by the Department of Natural Resources.

The task force must submit its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly by January 19, 2000.
