Senate Bill 652 (Senators Middleton and Mitchell)

Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Charles County - Matthew A. Henson Birthplace

This bill provides \$150,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Matthew A. Henson Commemorative Committee, Inc. for the acquisition of the land comprising the birthplace of Matthew A. Henson, a co-discoverer of the North Pole, the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a visitors' area on that land, and the planning, design, and procurement of a monument honoring Matthew A. Henson to be placed on the acquired land.

The board of directors must grant and convey a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$150,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
