House Bill 1093 (Delegate McKee) Economic Matters

## Insurance - Exemption from Regulation - Volunteer Fire Companies, Rescue Squads, and Ambulance Companies

This bill exempts volunteer fire companies, rescue squads, and ambulance companies that provide emergency ambulance services to subscribers from regulation under the Insurance Article.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None. The bill clarifies current practice.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** None. This bill clarifies that volunteer fire companies, rescue squads, and ambulance companies are not insurers and not subject to the provisions of the Insurance Article. Under current practice, if the full cost of ambulance services are not covered by a health care insurer, some volunteer fire companies will cover the difference for individuals if they become subscribers. In these cases, it could be construed that the volunteer fire company is an insurer. This bill clarifies that they are not insurers.
