Environmental Matters

Social Workers - Case Management - Standards of Practice

This bill requires the State Board of Social Work Examiners to adopt regulations governing the practice of case management by social workers. The regulations must: (1) define the types of case management functions appropriate to each level of social work licensure; (2) promote client self-determination; (3) assure appropriate confidentiality of client information; and (4) provide guidance for working cooperatively with other health professions and disciplines.
