House Bill 1024 (Delegate Rosenberg. *et al.*) Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - The Family Tree

This bill provides \$200,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to The Family Tree for the acquisition, planning, design, renovation, repair, and capital equipping of a building in Baltimore City to be used for child abuse prevention and parenting programs.

The Family Tree must provide \$200,000 in matching funds by June 1, 2001.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$200,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
