## FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 726 (Delegate A. Jones. *et al.*) Appropriations

#### Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Ruth McKissick Spann Adult Day Care Center

This bill provides \$350,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Ruth McKissick Spann Adult Day Care Center for the construction, development, and capital equipping of a 50 person adult day care facility to be located at 5024 Gwynn Oak Avenue in Baltimore.

The board of directors must provide \$350,000 in matching funds by June 1, 2001. No portion of the loan proceeds or the matching fund may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious purposes.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** This \$350,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.
