House Bill 1007 (Somerset County Delegation) Commerce & Government Matters

Somerset County - Authority of County Roads Board to Sell a Public Road

This bill authorizes the County Roads Board of Somerset County to sell a certain public road that is no longer needed for public use under terms and conditions determined by the board. Under current law, the board is required to hold a public sale in which property is transferred to the highest bidder.

The bill is effective July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Somerset County revenues could increase by \$32,577 in FY 2000. No effect on expenditures.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Revenues: The county road specified in the bill is currently closed. The Somerset County Roads Board advises that the sale of 980 feet of Costen Road would generate \$32,577 in revenues from the sale of the property to the one business that adjoins the road.
